The 9th Symposium on Turkish Cypriots who Left a Trace Behind organized by the Eastern Mediterranean University Center for Cyprus Studies (EMU-CCS) commenced with an opening ceremony which took place at the Rauf Raif Denktaş Culture and Congress Hall at 09:00 a.m. on Monday, the 21st of May 2018.

Before presentations, EMU Vice Rector for Administrative and Technical Affairs and EMU-CCS President Prof. Dr. Naciye Doratlı conveyed their thanks to the participants for their participations and gave brief information about EMU-CCS. Organized once every two years by EMU-CCS, the theme of this year's event was based on "Literature". Prof. Dr. Doratlı stated that the symposium will focus on Harid Fedai, Ali Nesim, Filiz Naldöven, Fikret Demirağ, Kutlu Adalı, M. Taner Baybars and Kaya Çanca, who have important contributions to the Turkish Cypriot literature. ## EMU FACULTY OF ARCHITECTURE AND INTBAU JOINT SEMINARS HAVE BEEN COMPLETED



The series of seminars organized by the Eastern Mediterranean University (EMU) Faculty of Architecture and INTBAU Cyprus, a regional organization of the International Network of Traditional Building, Architecture and Urbanism, continuing its activities on the island since 2010, have been completed.

In the seminar, which is the third of the Cultural Heritage Series, the topics which are titled "Common Heritage, Acheiropietos Monastery", "Ankara University Mustafa V. Koç Research Center, Contributions to Maritime Archaeology and Cultural Miracle", and "Effects of Ecotourism on Traditional Architecture; Bağlıköy

- Ambelikou" were discussed in the seminars with the participation of a large number of students, research assistants and academic staff of the Faculty of Architecture.

### Data Analysis

A series of presentations by Prof. Dr. Vasıf Şahoğlu from Ankara University, Assist. Prof. Dr. Makbule Oktay from Lefke European University, Assist. Prof. Dr. Alessandro Camiz from Girne American University were held as part of the event. Assist. Prof. Dr. Makbule Oktay handled the effects of ecotourism on traditional architectural influences in the context of cause-effect and

investigated Bağlıköy-Ambelikou in an in-depth manner. Assist. Prof. Dr. Oktay highlighted the values that Bağlıköy-Ambelikou gained or lost to the cities, gave examples on the research and projects carried out in this region and evaluated the results.

### Archeological Findings Presented

Professor Dr. Vasıf Şahoğlu emphasized how important cultural heritage is and contributed to the study of the important archaeological findings which they obtained and brought out in various places from underwater excavation studies conducted by Mustafa V. Koç Research Center at Ankara University.

Assist. Prof. Dr. Alessandro Camiz explained the documentation, digital survey studies, damage analysis and design stages for restoration which they made. Assist. Prof. Dr. Alessandro Camiz gave detailed information on how and why they applied specific techniques and analysis processes, and how they evaluated what they wanted and could achieve as a result.

After his closing speech, EMU Faculty of Architecture Dean Prof. Dr. Özgür Dinçyürek presented the speakers certificates and posters of the activity after he thanked them for the information they gave in the context of cultural heritage.

## “ORGAN TRANSPLANT IN TRNC” DISCUSSED IN EMU



Eastern Mediterranean University (EMU) Faculty of Health Sciences, Department of Health Management organized an informative Organ Donation seminar in collaboration with the TRNC Ministry of Health on May 21st, 2018 Monday at 10:00, at EMU Mustafa Afşin Ersoy Hall. A total of 25 organ transplants were carried out in the Turkish Republic of Northern Cyprus in 2015, with the approval of the “Cell, Tissue and Organ Transplantation Regulation” by the Council of Ministers, with 11 live and 14 brain deaths. The seminar’s slogan was “Don’t let your organs become dirt, let them come to life in a body” and the speaker of the event was Ministry of Health Internal Diseases and Nephrology Specialist Assoc. Prof. Dr. Düriye Deren Oygur.

In the opening speech, Prof. Dr. Mehtap Malkoç stated that effective communication in health care is very important because raises the awareness of society and overcome the misconceptions of such a seminar bring about the happiness of voicing. Prof. Dr. Malkoç also noted that they are prominent faculty with their social awareness projects. After Prof. Dr. Malkoç’s speech, EMU Vice Rector for Student Affairs, Prof. Dr. H. Tanju Besler noted that organ donation, an important issue in the TRNC, will be discussed at this meeting and is of great importance in terms of awareness-raising. Prof. Dr. Besler added that he hoped that this meeting would end with an important conclusion.

### Cadaveric Organ Transplant is in the forefront in developed countries

As a speaker, Assoc. Prof. Dr. Düriye Deren Oygur shared examples and information from all over the world as well as topics such as organ donation,



organ transplants, Cell, Tissue, Organ Transplant Law in TRNC. Attention to the importance of organ donation Assoc. Prof. Dr. Oygur noted that in developed countries, cadaveric organ transplant was at the forefront place and that this was a more appropriate treatment. Assoc. Prof. Dr. Oygur stated that by taken organs from the cadaver whose brain death occurred can give a chance to life for 8 people and added that a new the organ donation was made as a result of application to the Ministry of Health Coordination Board Secretariat. Assoc. Prof. Dr. Oygur mentioned that there are few people who are cadaver donors in the world and this is the problem of the whole world. Additionally, she gave information about organ transplants from cadaver rates such as in TRNC of 60%, in the UK %90, and in Turkey %10. Recalling that they are working to increase the rate of TRNC, Assoc. Prof. Dr. Oygur thanked EMU for supporting the realization of such an effective information seminar. İbrahim Yazıcı, a theologian who performed kidney transplantation

from a cadaver at the seminar, told about his returning to the life again. Emphasizing that organ donation has no drawbacks; Yazıcı also stated with a great importance that religion does not contradict science.

At the end of the informing seminar, Assoc. Prof. Dr. Düriye Deren Oygur was awarded a plaque by Mehtap Malkoç. At the seminar, District Governor of Gazimağusa Dürdane Acı, EMU Health Management Program Coordinator Erkan Malkoç, EMU Academic and

Administrative Staff and students gave support with their participations as well as many associations, institutions, organizations.

### 20 people donated their organs:

At the end of the seminar, the participants were informed that 20 people donated their organs and the organ donation records in EMU will continue until July, 1st 2018. Those who wish to apply or receive information can reach the Secretariat of the Faculty of Health Sciences at 630 3939.

## EMU'S OLYMPIC ATHLETE ESE BRUME JUMPS TO A WORLD LEAD



Eastern Mediterranean University's (EMU) 2015 African Long Jump champion, Nigerian athlete Ese Brume who came fifth at the Rio 2016 Olympic Games Long Jump competition and first at the 2014 Commonwealth Games took this year's world lead with a 6.82 jump at the first leg of the IAAF World Challenge Series 2018 long jump competition.

At the competition that took place on Saturday, the 19th of May 2018 at Kingston, Jamaica Ese Brume jumped 16 centimeters further than Olympic and World Champion American athlete Shakeelah Saunders to claim first place. Ese Brume who is only 21 years of age is being shown as the favorite for the 2020 Tokyo Olympic Games. Ese Brume who is continuing her training

with coaches Hasan Maydon and Yaya Kayode made the Turkish Republic of Northern Cyprus and EMU proud by obtaining a world leading jump in 2018.

May Commemoration of Atatürk Youth and Sports Day. Asst. Prof. Dr. Turgay Bülent Göktürk's statement reads as follows:

"19 May 1919 is the first day of national sovereignty. On this day, the first steps towards establishing the Republic of Turkey were taken. This is a day when a nation showed determination to exist despite vast absence. When Atatürk stepped foot on Samsun our National Independence Struggle Action Phase begun.

Atatürk's monumental work Nutuk firstly summarized his decision and the piteous situation of the Ottoman Empire when he arrived in Samsun on the 19 May 1919. Along with the nation, despite all difficulties Atatürk

managed to save the country from imperialistic occupying forces and carry out reforms to establish a modern Republic of Turkey which he describes as his most important work.

Great Leader Mustafa Kemal Atatürk entrusts the Republic to Turkish youth and explains how they will protect it in his Address to Turkish Youth.

Mustafa Kemal Atatürk emphasizes the importance he shows to this day by saying "19 May is my birthday". We are thankful and commemorate Atatürk, his fellow fighters and all martyrs who died to make this land our country. I wish you a happy 19 May Commemoration of Atatürk Youth and Sports Day.
