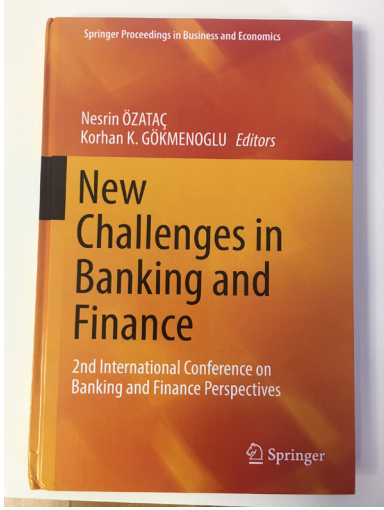


year. According to TOLES Coordinator Peril S. Emiroğluları who operates at

Memos of the conference entitled “International Banking and Finance Perspectives” conducted by Eastern Mediterranean University (EMU) Business and Economics Faculty, Banking and Finance Department on the 21st of April, 2017 are published in the international publishing house, Springer. Turkish Republic of Northern Cyprus (TRNC) Central Bank and various prestigious institutions supported the conference which had nearly 120 applicants from 15 different countries whom are specialists in the field of banking and finance. During the statement

made by the head of Conference Regulatory Board and also EMU Business and Economics Faculty, Banking and Finance Department Head, Assoc. Prof. Dr. Nesrin Özataç remarked the aim of the international conference that is to gather many scholars and bankers in TRNC to contribute the academic life.

Eminent and Prestigious Publishing House

By stating that the outcomes of the conference are compiled and collected into a book, Assoc. Prof. Dr. Özataç mentioned that the publishing

of the book was accomplished with the agreement settled with the prestigious publishing house Springer. The book consists of following issues; recent studies on banking and finance following the global finance crisis, opportunities and risks arise in global financial markets, effective monetary policies to be applied by Central Banks during the floating finance market periods, importance of supervision, Islamic banking, micro-finance, capital market economic growth and energy economy.

EMU REPRESENTED IN THE 1ST INTERNATIONAL ELEMENTARY EDUCATION CONGRESS

1st International Elementary Education Congress organized by Uludağ University took place in Bursa in the past few days. Eastern Mediterranean University (EMU) Faculty of Education was represented with a verbal notice during the congress.

EMU Elementary Education Department, Pre-school Teacher Education Post-Graduate Program graduate Specialist Şebnem Hürler presented her study entitled “Perceptions of University Students towards Emotional Abuse” under the counselling of her thesis advisor, Prof. Dr. Elif Yeşim Üstün. The study conducted with total of 810 university students (505 Turkish and 305 International) showed that majority of the students do

not get any training (courses, seminars, etc.) during their studies regarding negligence and abuse.

According to the findings of the study, the emotional abuse perceptions of students vary with factors such as gender, parental education and class level. The most interesting result of the study indicated that International students possess higher emotional abuse perceptions than Turkish students. The study suggest that more place should be given to seminars, courses, social responsibility projects in universities on negligence and abuse in order to raise awareness of students who are future parents. Moreover, the study emphasizes the need for a deeper analysis on the emotional abuse perceptions of youngsters.

In her sports career, Emine Uluçay won the first and second place in Turkey and is known as the first and only female “Ironman” throughout the island.

Eastern Mediterranean University (EMU) Business and Economics Faculty, Department of Banking and Finance is preparing to hold the "3rd International Conference on Banking and Finance Perspectives" on Wednesday the 25th of April 2018. The conference will commence at 10:00 with an opening ceremony taking place at the Rauf Raif Denктаş Culture and Congress Hall. The conference supported by the Turkish Republic of Northern Cyprus (TRNC) Central Bank will continue on the 26th and 27th of April 2018. Approximately 150 expert banking and finance academicians from 23 different countries have applied to participate in the conference. Following an opening speech by TRNC Minister of Economy and Energy Özdil Nami, prominent academician Prof. Dr. Philip Molyneux (University of Sharjah, UAE) will be delivering a presentation titled "Latest Developments and Future Work Opportunities in Banking". On the second day of the conference Prof. Dr. Colin C. Williams (University of Sheffield, England) will be delivering a presentation titled "Shadow Economy and Alternative Policies". On the third day of the conference Prof. Dr. Muhammad Shahbaz (University of

Montrpellier, France) will be delivering the presentation titled "The Effect of Asymmetric Growth on Financial Development".

In a statement released by the conference organization committee and EMU Banking and Finance Faculty Chair Assoc. Prof. Dr. Nesrin Özataç it was indicated that the international conference will bring together numerous academicians and bankers in the TRNC. The statement drew attention to the event's contribution to the country's academic environment and promotion. Assoc. Prof. Dr. Özataç stated that the conference will share the latest research on banking and finance after the global financial crisis. Opportunities and risks of global financial markets will also be discussed. The statement highlighted that 80 declarations will be discussed by international academicians from 23 different countries in 15 sessions. The sessions will be concerned with topics such as practices of central banks during fluctuant periods of the economy and financial markets, the importance of surveillance and audit, Islamic banking, micro finance, capital markets, economic development and energy economy.
